

Council 30 Apr 2009

Burton Village Special Council
30 April 2009

Mayor Blair called the Council meeting to order at 6:30 PM.

Roll Call: Sandy Humbert, Yes, Judy Beaumier, Yes, Gerald Rouge, No, Linda Swaney, Yes, Darren LaForce, Yes, Jeff Coleman, Yes.

Visitors: Jack Garner, Chad Eldridge, Lee Koroshes, Marty Motil.

Mayor Blair introduced Mr. Eldridge to present the various options available to the Village for paving North Cheshire. As background, Mayor Blair asked Mr. Koroshes to comment. Mr. Koroshes stated that he has been a resident on North Cheshire for thirty years and that over time the road has been overlaid with chip and seal material to the point that the road is higher than the driveways and raised level with any curbs.

Council expressed a desire to help alleviate this problem. Options for paving included various milling depths from 2 to 4 inches, not milling and paving the parking areas, and adding varying depths of asphalt depending upon the amount milled. Mr. Coleman offered several suggestions, noting that an exact figure would be hard to calculate. Council in general asked Mr. Eldridge if more asphalt would last longer.

Mr. Eldridge explained the various options noting that a deeper milling might reveal more problems if the base was not there to support it. Council discussed.

Mr. Coleman moved to have Hess and Associates prepare a bid for the project including the following criteria: Do not mill and repave the parking areas off North Cheshire. Mill three inches and fill three inches from the south end of the Park to the north side of Ford Lane. Mill 4 inches and fill three inches from the north side of Ford Lane to the south side of Cook Street and mill 3 inches and fill 3 inches from Cook Street to the north end of the Village. Ms. Humbert seconded the motion. Roll Call: Jeff Coleman – Yes, Sandy Humbert – Yes, Darren LaForce – Yes, Linda Swaney – Yes, and Judy Beaumier –Yes. Motion passed.

Mr. Eldridge will take this back to Mr. Hess and a bid package will be prepared and sent to the Village Office for advertising.

Mrs. Beaumier moved to adjourn and Mr. Coleman seconded the motion. By voice vote all approved. Meeting adjourned at 7:10 PM.
