

Burton Historic District
Architectural Review Board
Minutes
October 27, 2011

The meeting was called to order at 1:30 p.m.

Kurt Updegraff requested a sign permit for 14549 N. Cheshire St. He wants to replace the existing sign with one of the same design with the addition of the words "Buy Local-Buy Burton". The new sign will be slightly smaller and will contain 12 sections to be used to advertise the business district merchants. It will be painted brown. Mrs. Ronyak made the motion to approve the permit. Mr. Rouge 2nd. Rouge, Wohlken, Ronyak, & Hauser by voice vote approved the motion. Updegraff abstained.

Mr. Rouge made the motion to approve the 10/5/11 minutes. Mrs. Ronyak 2nd. Rouge, Wohlken, Ronyak, & Hauser by voice vote approved the motion. Updegraff abstained because he was not at the 10/5/11 meeting.

The Board discussed buying Historic District banners and perhaps developing a logo for the Burton Historic District. Mr. Rouge will look into the costs involved. We will need to decide on the number of banners and get three bids. Mr. Wohlken will discuss the project with the Burton Historic District Association to see if they want to help with the purchasing of the banners or designing of a logo. Mrs. Hauser will find out if hardware from previous banners still exists.
